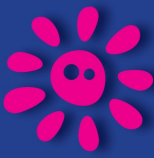

Potato Print Wrapping Paper

Have a go at adding a nice personal touch to your Christmas wrapping, with this fun potato printing activity!

Resources:

- A large roll of paper – brown parcel paper works well
- Raw potatoes
- A sharp knife
- Christmas themed cookie cutters
- Paint
- Paper plates
- Glitter/stickers/sequins - optional



Method:

1. Making sure your potatoes are nice and clean, cut them in half (you may need an adult to help you)
2. Push your cookie cutter into the flat side of the potato and use your knife to remove the edges.
3. Pour your paint onto separate paper plates for each colour and dip the potato into the paint and stamp it onto the paper.
4. You could make a repeated pattern, or just get creative and cover your paper with an assortment of Christmas images.
5. Add glitter or sparkles as a finishing touch and when everything has dried, your wrapping paper is ready to use!
