Have a go at adding a nice personal touch to your Christmas wrapping, with this fun potato printing activity!

Resources:

- A large roll of paper brown parcel paper works well
- Raw potatoes
- A sharp knife
- Christmas themed cookie cutters
- Paint
- Paper plates
- Glitter/stickers/sequins optional



Method:

- 1. Making sure your potatoes are nice and clean, cut them in half (you may need an adult to help you)
- Push your cookie cutter into the flat side of the potato and use your knife to 2. remove the edges.
- 3. Pour your paint onto separate paper plates for each colour and dip the potato into the paint and stamp it onto the paper.
- You could make a repeated pattern, or just get creative and cover your 4. paper with an assortment of Christmas images.
- Add glitter or sparkles as a finishing touch and when everything 5. has dried, your wrapping paper is ready to use!
